#### **ARTIST NIGHT**



Wednesday, February 28, 5:30-7:30pm

Please join us for a new Artist Night at the Art Club on February 28 from 5:30 to 7:30pm in the Masiello Studio, where we will view the documentary "Packed in a Trunk" about American Artist Edith Lake Wilkinson (1868 – 1957).

In 1924 Wilkinson was committed to an asylum by her then family attorney who wanted to control her new inheritance. A body of her paintings and prints were discovered forty years after her death in 1957. Born in West Virginia, and educated at Columbia College, Wilkinson studied at the Art Students League in New York City. Many of her woodcuts completed prior to 1914 are among the earliest examples of the White Line Woodcut.

The program will be introduced by Brian Larkin, a consultant on the film. There will be an opportunity for dialogue after the film along with a portfolio of work by Art Club members who have been inspired by Wilkinson and the White Line Woodcut.
