NATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR FOUNDER EDWARD BANNISTER

Art Club founding member Edward Mitchell Bannister is now recognized as a key figure in the history of American landscape painting. The National Gallery has acquired Palmer

River (1885), one of Bannister's most accomplished paintings.

Formerly in the collection of Art Club Member and former President Dan Mechnig, it is the first work by the artist to enter the collection.



We are excited to share the news of a public art project that is underway. The Bannister Project committee, consisting of PAC members and community leaders, has been formed to assist

in the realization and installation of a public art sculpture to honor the artist, with the goal of creating a broader platform for community engagement through partnerships, programming, a call for public art, and a Bannister scholarship. Stay tune for more information in the months ahead.

Ensuring a Structurally Sound Future for Our Club

In case you haven't noticed, a lot of work is being done to address our aging infrastructure at the Providence Art Club. Earlier this summer, we dealt with the plugged downspout adjacent to the front door, by redirecting the underground drainage pipe into the catch basin in the Moeity courtyard. In the fall, we replaced the central boilers and hot water tanks that service the Club. The new system will be more energy efficient and reliable. We have also replaced the air-conditioning systems in the Dodge House and in Angell's Lane. Now the bartenders will be cool!!!!

In mid October a new roof was installed at the Dodge House. The 15 year old rubber membrane roofs are being repaired and a new rubber roof will be installed under the deck, above the kitchen. All together over \$155,000 has been invested in these infrastructure improvements in the last 6 months. While we don't notice these changes, they are an important part of our stewardship of our irreplaceable historic buildings, and contribute to our comfort and enjoyment of the Club.
