President's Message

And just like that, we've wrapped 2021 with our most successful Little Pictures show in Club history!

The 117th Annual Little Pictures Show & Sale totaled over \$170,000 in artwork sales and sent well over 600 individual objects to new homes. A huge round of applause for our amazing staff who organized the show and welcomed thousands of visitors into the galleries, for the 120 artists who participated in the show for sharing their creativity, and for those who supported this exhibition with their patronage and promotion...Another round of applause for the House committee for making the Club shine with their signature level of spirit and artfulness, from inventive trees to antique toys...and finally, to the extended crew behind our first-ever block parties – with Marketing, member volunteers, studio tenants, and staff working together to perform some true holiday magic!

We are starting 2022 in terrific financial health (more on that in a bit), yet are once again in the midst of a COVID surge. Please, as we continue to take every precaution to keep our beloved Club a safe place for all in our community – stay home if you feel unwell, get vaccinated if you have not already done so, and get your booster – let's give the shot a shot!

Even in the shadow of Omicron, there was much to celebrate about 2021 – here's a short but sweet list to keep our spirits bright as we head into these darker months:

Our Membership committee welcomed 51 members into our Club, and made welcoming potential members easier though events and a clearer application process. They also published a cookbook, with a second book ("Studio Tips") on the way!

Our Art committee mounted a range of exhibitions this year that continued to expand our dialogue with the community-at-large; including a show of smartphone photos, a first-ever open-air sculpture show, a series featuring nationally recognized organizations (the Society of American Graphic Artists and the Boston Printmakers), as well as our own PAC artists (the Hot Type Print Portfolio, which was auctioned for the benefit of the Club and accessioned into the Smithsonian National Museum of American History Graphic Arts Collection!) Their Rhode Island Community Invitational served to launch the current effort to create additional PAC gallery space for similar co-programming.

Our Collections Committee organized a magnificent Angela O'Leary show and put on a haunting Members Night, while working behind the scenes to continue the process of inventorying, cataloguing (this year, adding a few hundred art works into the digital database), and refining the Club's collection of fine art – including formalizing Accessioning/Deaccessioning policies.

Our Education committee continues to offer outstanding programming and will look to continue to expand our curriculum as well as the number of attendees allowed into our classes. (Speaking of expansion, the committee is offering PAC's first European trip – to Ireland – this May. Registration has been strong so far – if all goes well, look for more international and domestic trips.)

Our Finance committee reports that the Club has a strong balance sheet and operating statement due to a rigorous budget process that keeps expenses in proportion to the operations of the Club; strong investment returns for our portfolio, two PPP grants, and a Payroll Tax credit which bolstered our cash position.

Thank you all for your continued support - through taking classes, dining, your gifts of time and financial donations, and the introduction of new members!

Nancy K Anderson, Curator and Head of the Department of American and British Paintings, has stated that our beloved Edward Mitchell Bannister is now recognized as a key figure in the history of American landscape painting.

Bannister began his exploration into landscape painting in the mid-1860's. Today, his most recognized painting, "Palmer River", hangs proudly in National Gallery of Art as the first of many works to enter their Bannister Collection. To recognize Bannister's accomplishments and contributions to art, Providence Art Club is working on the construction of a statue of his likeness that will sit at Market Square on the Providence River.
