CHAZAN! Book Talk & Signing

Thursday, April 28th, 6pm

Whether you're interested in healthcare, arts and media, or our little home state, chances are that you've heard the name Dr. Joseph Chazan, famously known for his immense contributions to nephrology and the arts. As the founder and president of Nephrology Associates, Inc., Dr. Chazan single-handedly brought salvation and ease to not only his own nephrology patients, but all nephrology patients by enacting the first dialysis clinic in Rhode Island. Previously having to travel as far as Boston for their dialysis treatments, Dr. Chazan is considered to be a superhero to these people for bringing their treatments much closer to home. Dr. Chazan remains very involved with Rhode Island healthcare as an advocate for the people, spending his time serving the medical patients of Rhode Island through various projects and boards spearheaded by Joseph Chazan himself. That's why, as a public figure so involved in medicine and healthcare. it raised some serious eyebrows from his peers when they learned of Dr. Chazan's passion for the arts.

As one of the largest patrons of the living local arts scene, Chazan's support to the community doesn't stop with his service to medicine. After all, everyone has their own fascination that ignites the passion and creativity within. Dr. Chazan's is visual art, local artists, and the spaces they use to exhibit, playing an instrumental role in the establishment of Providence's *AS220*, local watering hole and gallery space for creatives. Starting as a way to relax with his late wife, Helene, Dr. Chazan began collecting art in the 1970's. Since then, his collection has bloomed into an impressive exhibit of his own, pieces of which he donates frequently to various museums and art galleries.

Dr. Chazan's inspiring life of feeding his soul with medicine and art is broken down into easily digestible comic strips in his graphic novel Chazan! Unfiltered. The story follows the premise of a grandfather sitting down and telling his grandson about his life...straight from his own point of view. Dr. Chazan's larger than life, energetic personality shines through in the pages of this story, written by award-winning playwright and screenwriter Lenny Schwartz and illustrated by Big Nazo founder and performance artist, Erminio Pingue. Join us at Providence Art Club on April 28th, 2022 to learn more about the process of creating the book, stories that didn't make it in, and more, as Dr. Chazan, Erminio Pinque, and Lenny Schwartz reminisce about this project and answer questions from the audience, followed by an opportunity to have your own copy signed by all three authors. CELEBRATING Edward Bannister

Continuing news about the Bannister Community Art Project

Most recently, a letter was sent to the membership providing more information about this exciting project. A public art community initiative that was brought to us by Sculptor, Gage Prentiss. A bust of Mr. Bannister by Gage Prentiss was gifted to the Art Club by an anonymous donor and now resides in the Founders Room.

As the Fiscal Agent and Administrator for this project, PAC's involvement affords significant ways to build and strengthen community goodwill. By promoting Bannister's historic role in the Providence Art Club and beyond, we have the opportunity to broker cross-cultural relationships, create opportunities for educational programs, call for public art, as well as establish a Bannister scholarship. As an independent advisory committee and steering committee comprised of PAC members and members of the community, they will be working with other like-minded non-profits, such as Stages of Freedom, RISD, the John Nicholas Brown Center for Public Humanities; and the Rhode Island Historical Society. These collaborative efforts will enable us to develop programs that expand PAC's efforts towards diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Also, at this writing, we are happy to report approval of a grant by the Papitto Opportunity Connection which means we are 75% of our goal of \$200,000. for the creation and installation of the Bannister Sculpture. Additional funds will be raised to support programs, exhibitions and a proposed scholarship fund.
