REIMAGINING A CHILD'S VISION

Currently on view in the *Barrington Public Library* is a unique collection of woodblock prints. The actual woodblocks (displayed alongside the prints) were created and preserved in the 1950's-60's by the young students of Gino Conti, a well known and respected Rhode Island artist and teacher. Fast forward to today, the woodblocks have been donated to the *Providence Art Club* for all of us to enjoy!

Several PAC members decided to "reimagine" these old woodblocks by restoring the blocks to their former, print-ready glory, and then incorporating printing ink, paint, paper, and other materials to create their new images. While these final prints have taken on a new life, their childlike charm and character is still reflected through the work. All proceeds from this show will benefit the Lifespan Healing Arts Program at Hasbro Children's Hospital. This show will open Saturday, June 4th and run until July 31st, with an Artists' Reception on June 23rd, 2022 from 4-6pm. More information on this exhibit can be found at barringtonlibrary.org.
