### **Behind the Brush:**

Kelly McCullough on Passions & Challenges

She feels truly blessed with the way her life continues to unfold and wants to thank her close friend and spiritual guide Sally Ewalt – for teaching her the true meaning of self-kindness.

Kelly loves taking on new challenges. In fact, she has recently adopted the role of Club Silhouette painter, calling on Jim Allen for his years of knowledge. Though the process may seem daunting, she is excited at the prospect of portraying respected members' likeness in a manner unlike her usual portraits. Among her many passions are song writing, practicing and teaching yoga, and continually learning new things – focusing on the beauty of the process. Kelly believes you have to allow yourself to be bad at something if you want to see improvement.


