

THE PAC'S QUIET PATRON AND PHILANTHROPIST

Did you identify the PAC silhouette in our February newsletter? The likeness in the Green Room is of Isaac Comstock Bates – one of the Club's first patrons who truly embraced the spirit of philanthropy who, in the late 19th century, amassed an art collection on par with Peggy Guggenheim. Bates then gave everything away, forever changing the Rhode Island art world by donating the foundational collection of the RISD Museum and providing support to the Providence Art Club and its artists.

On May 9 from 5:30-7:30pm the PAC Development Committee will host a FREE special event featuring RISD Museum curators who will discuss Bates's astounding collection and his lasting legacy of quiet philanthropy, plus a visit from one of Issac's living relatives.

The RISD Museum received more than 2,400 pieces of art from Bates, who during his lifetime served as a director, vice president,

and president of the Museum board. Bates's personal collection included paintings, etchings and engravings by Rembrandt, Winslow Homer, William Merritt Chase, Frank Weston Benson, William Morris Hunt, Eastman Johnson, Albrecht Durer, George Inness, Jean-Baptiste-Camille Corot, Gilbert Stuart and Childe Hassam, as well as numerous pieces of jewelry, ceramics, sculpture, and 600 Asian art objects.

An early and devoted member of the PAC, Bates enjoyed discovering emerging artists and was crucial to the careers of many PAC greats, including Edward Bannister, Sydney Burleigh, and Charles Walter Stetson. He also secured several of the PAC's buildings and was the first contributor to what is now called the Florence B. Kane Society for legacy donations to the PAC.

Nick Paciorek : "Draw to Paint, Paint to Draw"

July 16th , 17th, 18th | 3 Day Workshop 9am-3pm

Students will learn three different drawing lessons that will help their individual painting techniques. These three drawing techniques will help students understand tone, line and shape so they can bring that into their individual painting style. Open to students of all levels, and all mediums. Come to find your language in your work through the use of seeing.

In the morning, we will do drawing exercises that will help students understand how drawing can affect how paint goes on the canvas. I ask that students bring three canvas and images to be worked on in the afternoon so we can apply the drawing technique we learned in the morning to the canvas.
