In 2020 the Board of Managers (BOM) amended the Club's Constitution and one of the resulting changes was to implement BOM term limits and institute succession planning for new members and officers. - · And finally, conversations have begun to analyze the elements of the PAC membership experience. Understanding what the Club's diverse membership values and expectations from their PAC affiliation will inform future planning and investment decisions.
